

Mount Lawley Bowling Club Men's Consistency Singles 2023

Conditions of Play.

1. General Conditions

- 1.1 The Laws of Bowls (Crystal Mark 4th Edition), as adopted by Bowls Australia except as varied hereunder, shall apply.
- 1.2 The Mount Lawley Men's Consistency Singles Committee shall be responsible for the management and operation of the event.

2. Entry Conditions.

- 2.1 The Mount Lawley Bowling Club Men's Consistency Singles is open to all male bowlers who are registered as a member of an affiliated club with a State or Territory Association affiliated to Bowls Australia.
- 2.2 In the Mount Lawley Bowling Club Consistency Singles a non-negotiable condition of entry is that defeated players are required to mark in the following round.

3. Playing Conditions

- 3.1 Singles - 4 bowls per player in a Knock Out format.
- 3.2 Scoring is determined by the 4 bowls closest to the Jack, the closest being 4, the next 3, then 2, then 1. The score of the 2 players for each end should total 10, provided there are 4 bowls left on the rink.
- 3.3 The first player to reach a total of 120 (semi- final 130 & final 150) at the completion of an end is the winner. If the game is tied, the players are to toss a coin to determine who takes the mat for the additional end. If still tied then continue playing ends until a winner can be determined.
- 3.4 Dead Ends are to be replayed.
- 3.5 Trial ends 2 way prior to commencement of game; also when changing greens.
- 3.6 No player is permitted to go to the head until after they have bowled their third bowl.
- 3.7 Starting times to be advised on completion of the Draw.
- 3.8 **Markers** – as per Entry Condition 2.2 in the Mount Lawley Bowling Club Consistency Singles defeated players are required to mark in the following round.
- 3.9 Entry Fee \$25
