ORDINARY	Entitled to all rights and privileges of the club, including the right to vote and hold office in the club	\$300.00
PENSIONER	Members whose principal means of support is derived from Invalid, Widows, Old Age, or similar Social Service Pension. Such members are entitled to exercise the full privileges of the Club. (Seniors Card not acceptable)	\$250.00
ORDINARY NEW MEMBER	New bowlers who have never been members of a bowling club before. Includes Club shirt	\$160.00
RECREATIONAL	Recreational members shall not be entitled to vote nor to hold office in the club. They are not entitled to play in Club Championship Competitions. They can play a limited number of Pennant games. They shall be entitled to such other privileges as shall be decided by the Management Committee from time to time, including the right, at the invitation of the Management Committee, to take part in bowls events designed to include them.	\$120.00
PROVISIONAL	Full playing members of any other club affiliated with Bowls WA. They are entitled to such club privileges and playing rights as decided by the Management Committee. They are not entitled to vote, hold office in the club, or compete in club championship events. They may play pennants following approval of a Multiple Club Pennant Application. The membership of a provisional member will cease when he or she ceases to be a full playing member of another affiliated club.	\$120.00
JUNIOR	Must be persons under the age of 18 yrs. They are entitled to such playing privileges as decided by the Committee, but shall not be entitled to vote or hold office in the club. Their rights to club facilities are governed by the requirements of the Liquor Act.	\$100.00
SOCIAL	Entitled to the privileges of the club but are not entitled to vote or hold office in the Club, or to play or practice bowls. Social members may receive lessons in the game of bowls, with the understanding that they will upgrade their membership to a playing category when ready to begin playing bowls.	\$30.00
